

Accident & Injury Policy:

Whilst we treat safety as our main priority, occasional accidents and injuries are inevitable. You can assist the Club by ensuring that the Medical Details section is completed with any relevant information. Should an accident or injury take place during training basic first aid will be provided onsite. If the injury requires more than this you will be called, please make sure all your contact details are up to date, and in an emergency an ambulance would also be called.

I have read and understood the Accident & Injury Policy, and consent to basic First Aid being administered where deemed necessary.

Image & Photograph Policy:

North Somerset Athletic Club is committed to providing a safe environment for children and young people under the age of 18, also vulnerable adults who may be a member of the Club. Photographs are sometimes taken at training and competitions, which are used to promote/celebrate activities and achievements of the Club. If you become aware that these images are being used inappropriately, or you wish to have images of your child removed from promotional material, please contact the Club's Welfare Officer at welfare@nsac.org.uk

Whilst athletes are competing, or training off site, we are unable to restrict who takes photos of your athlete (these photographers may not be part of the Club) for example at Avon Leagues or YDL where the events are open to the public. If there is a child welfare concern relating to this, please let us know by emailing welfare@nsac.org.uk

Drop-Off / Collection:

All athletes are required to register their attendance and report to the Coach in charge. It is expected that all under 16s should be delivered to training by a parent, or responsible adult. At the end of the session a responsible adult should collect athletes from the Coach or helper. If you are happy for your child to travel independently, please inform the Club's Welfare Officer at welfare@nsac.org.uk

How we use your data:

When you become a member of, or renew your membership with, North Somerset Athletic Club you can also choose to be registered as a member of England Athletics (you will have to register with England Athletics if you want to compete for the Club under the UKA rulebook). By confirming your registration, you are accepting that we will provide England Athletics with your personal data, which they will use to enable access to an online portal for you (called *MyAthletics*). England Athletics will contact you to invite you to sign into and update your *MyAthletics* portal (which, amongst other things, allows you to set and amend your privacy settings). If you have any

questions about the continuing privacy of your personal data when it is shared with England Athletics, please contact dataprotection@englandathletics.org.

If you are happy to provide your athlete's Ethnicity, please could you complete this in the "Ethnicity – optional box". This information is sometimes requested by England Athletics to demonstrate our diversity and can also be requested when we apply for grants or funding assistance. Any information provided to external bodies would be anonymised and only be a breakdown of Ethnicity for our Club members.
